A2: Please see the [Federally Funded Projects Amendment section](#) on Davis-Bacon Act that reads the following: **Davis-Bacon Act, as amended (40 U.S.C. 276a to a-7) (projects in excess of \$2,000.00)** – If required by the Federal program legislation, Vendor covenants and agrees that all laborers and mechanics employed by Vendor and its subcontractors on this project will be paid in compliance with the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 276a to a-7) and as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR part 5, "Labor Standards Provisions Applicable to Contracts Governing Federally Financed and Assisted Construction"). Under this Act, Vendor is required to pay wages to laborers and mechanics at a rate not less than the minimum wages specified in a wage determination made by the Secretary of Labor. In addition, Vendor is required to pay wages not less than once a week.
