- **8.** This project <u>MUST</u> be completed by 3/1/2023. Failure to achieve substantial completion by the stipulated date will incur LD's as stated in the contract. Substantial completion is outlined in the AIA A105. Owner is offering incentives for early completion as refrenced in the contract.
- 10. Terms of payment are outlined in AIA A105.
- 11. Existing subgrade infrastructure has been shown to the best of our knowledge. If any of the existing conditions are found to be materially different, or conduits and/or infrastructure is found to be at risk of being damaged during construction, the engineer should be notified immediately so that an amendment to the design and scope of work may be developed. Changes to the scope that affect the cost of the work will be addressed as outlined in the contract.
